Volunteers can help maintain the beauty in our local parks, trails and creeks.


If you have a favorite park in your neighborhood, you can help with projects such as picking up litter, raking leaves, washing picnic tables and benches, and so much more.

Individual/Small Group Opportunities

Activities for any park:

- Pick up litter along a trail, sidewalk, or at a park
- Rake leaves during the Fall months
- Wash and/or paint picnic tables or benches
- Pull weeds
- Spread wood chips
- Clean play structures
- Scrape gum off sidewalk and concrete areas

Activities for individual parks:

- Clean up leaves, sidewalks, or trim low hanging branches at Diana Park
- Trim hedges along the pathways at Paradise Park
- Repair and/or replace wood benches at Paradise Park
- Wash tennis courts at Community Park
- Fill in the holes at the ball fields and dog park at Community Park
- Clean the drinking fountains at Community Park, Galvan Park, or Paradise Park
- Remove debris from the sidewalk under the underpass on Monterey
- Cut weeds hanging over the sidewalk and sweep the sidewalk at Monterey and Jarvis
- Fill sandbags during the Fall months at the Corp Yard
- Prune roses in January and deadhead flowers in the Spring and Summer at the CCC

Large Group/Community Opportunities

Activities for individual parks

- Galvan Park – Paint a “Welcome to Galvan Park” sign on the side of the handball court that faces the parking lot
- Civic Center – Refurbish pathway native plant garden, remove raised edging material and replace with redwood bender board
- Howard Weichert Park – Construct a new pathway between the basketball court and the Cordova Court park entrance
- Stone Creek Park – Make smooth and leveled surfaces by adding new layer of decomposed granite paving
- Diana Estates – Repair retaining wall, paint metal fence posts and repair bent chain link fence fabric.
- Calle Asta (Belle Estates) and Sunrise Meadows
- Paint rusty metal fence and gate on E Main Ave
- Jackson Park – Improve pathways, prep and paint metal bridge railing.
- CRC/AC- Scrub pools, move lane lines
- Dog Park- Refurbish message board
- Butterfield Channel – Pick up litter

Adopt a Park/Trail/Spot Opportunities

Activities for any park:

- Pick up litter, rake leaves, perform light pruning on a routine basis.
- Maintain flower planting at sign; plant, water, weed, etc.

Activities for individual parks

- Civic Center Native Plant Demonstration Garden – Assist with weeding, pruning, leaf raking, and replanting.
- Downtown Courthouse Demonstration Garden • Assist with weeding, pruning, leaf raking, and replanting.
- Paradise Park Rose Bed – Water, trim, fertilize, dead head as needed; usually weekly.
- CCC – Adopt the rose garden.
- Library Entrance – Adopt native perennial flower bed.
- Residential Medians – Adopt a median; weed, trim, and plant.
