## What is **SB1186?**

**DISCLAIMER:** On September 19, 2012 Governor Brown signed into law SB-1186 01/01/2013 (Dutton; Special access: liability), a new law which <u>imposes a \$1.00 State fee on every applicant for a local business license or renewal</u> (including all in-city commercial and home-based, all exempts, all non-profits, landlords, out-of-city, and all contractors) and is required to be collected by all cities and counties throughout California, including the City of Morgan Hill.

## This new law requires that you be provided the following notices:

Under federal and state law, compliance with disability access laws is a serious and significant responsibility that applies to all California building owners and tenants with buildings open to the public.
