## FIRE STATION

### Features

- Drought tolerant plants
- Drip irrigation
- Mulch ground cover

Located on the corner of East Dunne Avenue and Hill Road, this small corner lot emphasizes drought tolerant plants and large rock features. Mulch and drip irrigation are in place reducing water waste. This location is the typical size of a residential front or back yard lawn and by converting it to a drought tolerant landscape is able to save roughly 28,667 gallons of water per year.
