



Community Input on Future Watsonville Road Trails and Greenways Grant Funding Possibilities

The City of Morgan Hill is in the planning process for future improvements along Watsonville Road to include a Class I pedestrian/bicycle trail and a pedestrian activated signal crossing, with the possibility of applying for a grant through the California Natural Resources Agency to fund the development. This funding program provides non motorized infrastructure development and enhancements that promote new or alternate access to parks, waterways, outdoor recreational pursuits and other natural environments to encourage health-related active transportation and opportunities for Californians to reconnect with nature.
